## POLICY

Develop and adopt it right away!

- Share it across your supply chain & with Program teams
- Incorporate it as part of any selection process
- Track the level of adoption of your suppliers

## TRAINING

## TARGETS

Assess your impact and establish KPI's  
Consider:

- Banning single use plastics
- Use only recycled (and unbleached) cardboard and paper
- Recycle at least 50% of materials after use

## MONITORING

- Regularly track suppliers' sustainability efforts & support them with greener product specifications & practices
- Review your policy on a regular basis and involve management & Programs to support you!
- Share your progress with the humanitarian logistics community through the WREC

## SUPPLIER EVALUATION

- Best practice is to consider **at least 10%** of your criteria to be focused on sustainability
